**Notice on the Revised Format of Selection Procedure to All PG Diploma
Courses 2020-21, in IIMC**

As has been announced on September 3, 2020 through a public notice, the IIMC will hold entrance test for all its eight (8) PG Diploma courses (including language journalism courses) for 2020-21 academic year.

The remote proctored online entrance examination will be conducted on **18th October 2020** (Sunday) by National Testing Agency (NTA).

Accordingly, a fresh round of applications is invited from the interested candidates. Last date of submission of application is **23rd September 2020**.

Those who have already applied, NEED NOT apply again. However, they may have to follow fresh instructions, if any, being forwarded by NTA in the conduct of the examination. They will be intimated in due course.

The candidates can take the admission test remotely from their home or a place of their choice. They need to have a desktop or laptop computer with good internet connection.

Those applicants who have already applied but want to withdraw from the currently proposed (entrance test based) admission process can do so by sending an email quoting their URN (Unique Registration Number) and payment details to this email id: academiciimc1965@gmail.com by 18th September 2020.

They will be returned the application fee paid earlier, minus the processing charge, within the next two weeks. Applicants will not be allowed to withdraw from one course while continuing with other courses.

Those holding a Degree certificate or appearing /awaiting result of their graduation examination can appear for the admission test and their final selection will be subject to the production of their graduation result/marks-sheet as and when the same is granted by the respective universities/institutions, latest by 15th December 2020.

The 2020-21 academic session is tentatively scheduled to begin in the second week of November. The classes for the first semester for all PG Diploma courses will be held in online mode.
